SPRINGFIELD--May 17, 2017--The Lincoln Land Charity Championship is offering a Stay-and-Play vacation package to the World Golf Hall of Fame for one lucky tournament volunteer. "This package is a golf enthusiast's dream come true," explained Kate Peters, executive director of the Lincoln Land Charity Championship. The course has hosted several notable tournaments including the LPGA's State Farm Classic from 2007-2011 and last year hosted the NCAA Division II Super Regionals and the Great Lakes Valley Conference Golf Championship.
